

# TREATMENT/ ADVICE ON DISCHARGE

- Exclusive Breasffeeding till 6 months of age.
- **Burping after feeds.**
- Warm care (Avoid over-bundling and underclothing)
- Vitamin D3 drops (800 IU/ ml) 0.5ml orally per day for 6 months

Watch out for Yellowish discoloration.

Follow up in 2 days.
